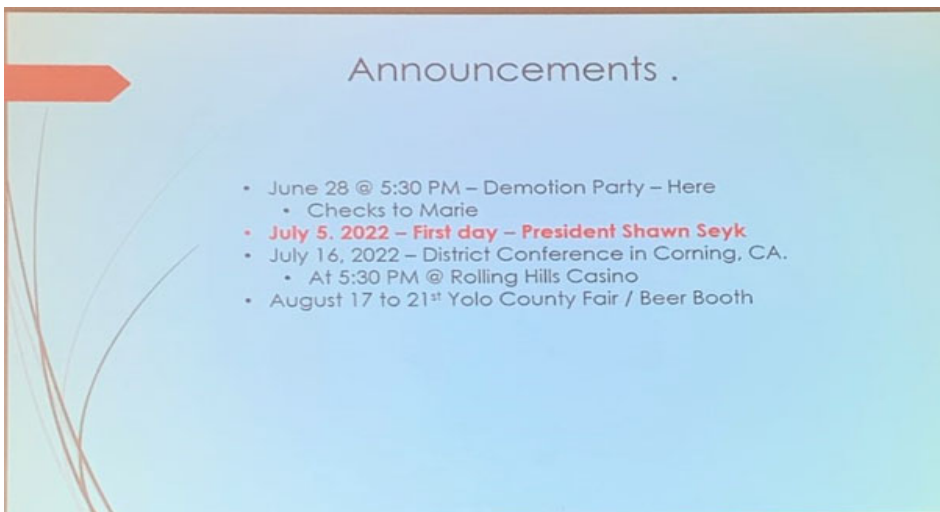
Visiting Rotarians and Guests

Today's Program

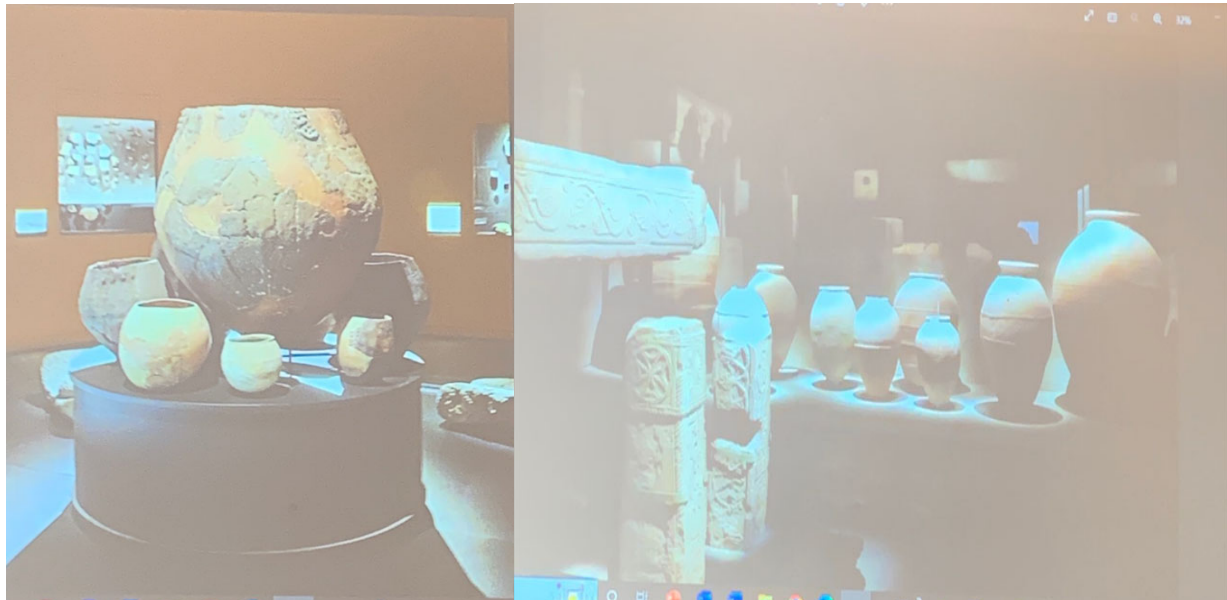


Our guest speaker today was Gary Wirth. He spoke to us about Georgia's Natural Wines. This is the country Georgia, not the state of Georgia.





Wine in Georgia is mostly made in a Qvevri. The Qvevri is an egg-shaped container that is used for ageing and storing the wine. The juice from the grapes is poured into the Qvevri and then it is sealed and buried in the ground so that the wine can ferment.
